The Board can choose to act or to delegate authority to a designated committee or to the WFA Executive Committee. The Board reserves the right to take actions including, but not limited to, removing an individual from a meeting without warning, prohibiting an individual from attending future WFA meetings, terminating an individual's affiliation with the WFA, and notifying an individual's employer. Retaliation against any person who files a complaint in good faith, or assists in the investigation of such a complaint, is also a violation of this policy and may be subject to disciplinary action.
